

SECTION W – WOOL

ENTRY FEE: \$1.00

First prize \$5 and ribbon, second \$2 and ribbon (three or more entries or no second prize).

NB: All merino fleeces are eligible to be judged on highest commercial value (except class 8)

CONDITIONS:

1. The judge is entitled to transfer any entry to another section if he considers it wrongly entered.
2. Rams wool only eligible for class 8 and Grand Champion Fleece.
3. All Fleeces to be skirted, skirtings not to be included.
4. ALL FLEECES TO BE GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR AND TO BE THE PRODUCT OF THE 2011 CLIP.
5. Unless otherwise specified exhibits will be judged in accordance with the following scale of points:
Soundness, Length, Colour, Softness, Density, Character, Evenness, Trueness of Type, Top and Noil Products (Weight and Yield). Total 100 points.
6. Fleeces not to exceed 12 months growth.

Wool exhibits may be left with the Secretary any time prior to the Show.

Entries to be on the ground by 10 a.m. on the first day of the Show.

1. Merino Wool, Superfine, one fleece - wether or ewe.
2. Merino Wool, Fine, one fleece - wether or ewe.
3. Merino Wool, Medium to Fine, one fleece - wether or ewe.
4. Merino Wool, Strong, one fleece - wether or ewe.

5. Comeback Wool, one fleece 58 to 60's. Spinning quality.
6. Crossbred Wool, one fleece, 56's. Spinning quality.
7. Crossbred Wool, one fleece, Medium 50's. Spinning quality.

CHAMPION CROSSBRED FLEECE. Ribbon and trophy.

8. Ram Fleece.
9. Merino Lamb's Wool. Fine, 500 grams.
10. Merino Lamb's Wool. Medium or Strong, 500 grams.
11. Crossbred Lamb's Wool. Fine, 500 grams.
12. Crossbred Lamb's Wool. Medium or Strong, 500 grams.
13. Comeback Lamb's Wool, 500 grams.
