Conditions of entry:

- . Entries, Stall Bookings and Camping to be made at www.globalentriesonline.com.au
- . Entries for Showjumping open Tuesday 17th January 2017 at 7.00 pm.
- . Entries for all events close Wednesday, 15 February 2017 at 7.00 pm.
- . Late entries will incur an extra \$5 fee per event.
- . Junior Definition: From the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 18.
- . Classes may be altered/deleted or added by the committee for the benefit of the riders present.
- . Amateur Rider Definition: Is a rider 21 years and over who has never competed in an Olympic Games/WEG or World Cup for Jumping Riders. Must not have competed in the Jumping events at Royal Shows or 4* 3 day events in the past two years. Must not have competed in A or B (1.30m) grade events in the last two years. Amateur riders cannot compete in an event higher than 1.20 m at the 2017 Gundagai show.
- . Only 2 official height classes per horse per day.
- . Horse/rider combination can only enter A or B in any class.
- . Course Walk at 7:30 AM each morning with a 8:00 AM first horse on Course.

Keep Dogs on a leash at all times. No dogs allowed in the main showground.

This is an Agricultural Show so there will be other events held on the Friday and Saturday. Although at this stage it will be only showjumping on the Sunday

The Gate Marshals are all volunteers. Please Respect this and keep courtesy, they are trying as hard as possible to keep the show moving!!

HOSSEIN SHAFIEE (RAMIN)

(International Show Jumping Course Designer)

Hossein Shafiee (Ramin) started riding horses on the age of 6 when his father competed in show jumping competitions. He participated, and was placed in many national show jumping competitions during his riding career and when he finished his University on Horse Breeding he started assisting the course designers at the age of 16.

He attended the Course Designers Seminar in Warendorf (GER) and was promoted to International Candidate Course Designer at the age of 21 as one of the youngest International show jumping course designer in 2001 when he already designed several top national shows in IRAN.

During 2003 he was promoted to be International course designer and participated in Athens Olympic Games 2004 as the member of Course Design team.

In 2005 he built CSI2* Moorseele and followed up his course designing career by designing courses for International shows in Asia and Europe until the International Federation for Equestrian Sports (FEI) appointed him as the course designer of FEI Children's International competition in 2010 for all three categories and the final in Hong Kong.

In 2011 he continued his activity by designing courses of the inland Nations cup and Olympic Game qualification in Hamina Bastioni when the FEI appointed him to designing courses of FEI World Jumping Challenge 2012 and the final in Venezuela.

In 2014 the organisers of the Winter Equestrian festival of Wellington in USA, as one of the major International events in the world, invited him to design courses for the DeNemethy arena, which also continued in 2015.

Once again in 2015 FEI he was appointed as the course designer of FEI Children's International Classics and also the Technical Delegate of Central Asian Championship in Almaty.

In 2015 the FEI sent him to Georgia & Japan, as the course Directors assistant for Course Designing Courses.

He designs courses in Asia, Europe, Africa and America in National and International levels during the last 14 years includes his activities as Steward in many national and International events and acting as the Chef d'Equip of IRANIAN Riders in International events.

In AEF General Assembly of 2015 the Asian National Federations elected him as the new Chairman of Jumping Committee of Asian Equestrian Federation

Including building at the Gundagai Show in 2016, Ramin also built courses in Belgium, The Winter Equestrian Festival in USA, South Africa, Canada, Iran, Georgia, Germany, Italy, South Korea, Algeria, Thailand and many more!!
